

China Peace Flag



The current flag of China (like the flags of Vietnam and the former Soviet Union) is a pure Communist banner, which symbolizes only Communism and nothing else except Communism – so ignoring all aspects of Chinese history, culture, and nationhood other than the triumphal march of Communism. The Chinese authorities should now be sufficiently mature to acknowledge non-Communist symbols of China’s history (especially if they wish to accomplish a peaceful conciliation with Taiwan). So the “China Peace flag” shown above includes all of the main national Chinese vexillological symbols of the twentieth century (keeping in mind that the twelve-rayed sun was devised by Sun Yat Sen, not Chang Kai Shek). The five stars are equal, to symbolize hopes of democracy. The basic layout was inspired by the five-striped horizontal red·yellow·blue·white·black Chinese flag of 1912:
